



# Are You Eligible to Enroll in a Building Operator Certification Course at No Charge?

## **BOC® is a national workforce training and credential program**

offering job skills in energy efficient building operation and maintenance practices. BOC® has received funding from the Sound Energy Efficiency Development (SEED) project that will cover the entire registration fee for a Level I or Level II BOC course for eligible registrants. SEED is a Department of Labor (DOL) Partnership grant to provide training for workers that prepares them to enter or advance in the energy efficiency and renewable energy industries.



## **Eligible participants can earn their Building Operator Certification credential at no cost!**

Certification is competency-based and offered at two levels: Level I emphasizes energy-efficient building maintenance practices; Level II stresses advanced equipment troubleshooting and maintenance.

## **You may be eligible for grant funding if you are:**

- 18 years of age or older
- Currently employed or unemployed and in need of updated BOC training
