



# OSHA 7225: Transitioning to Safer Chemicals

This course covers recognizing hazards and risks associated with a pandemic event - **such as influenza and novel coronavirus** - and developing strategies to assist a business, community, or family with realistic preparation for a pandemic event.

## COURSE OVERVIEW

**OSHA 7225: Transitioning to Safer Chemicals** gives participants hands-on experience with innovative processes for transitioning to safer chemicals, as well as the new methods, tools, and databases that can assist in this process. The course will guide participants through OSHA's seven-step substitution planning process for understanding and evaluating chemical use, identifying and assessing alternatives, and implementing those alternatives that are safer.

## INTENDED AUDIENCE

Small business owners, supply chain managers, and purchasing staff, maintenance supervisors, quality control managers, facility managers, and workers who utilize hazardous chemicals at their work-sites, along with occupational safety and health professionals and pollution prevention specialists who provide technical assistance on the control of chemical hazards.
